



MITIGATING ANALYST COGNITIVE BIAS BY ELIMINATING TASK HEURISTICS



BIAS BLIND SPOT: THE TENDENCY FOR INDIVIDUALS TO BE UNAWARE OF THEIR OWN COGNITIVE BIASES, EVEN WHEN THE INDIVIDUALS CAN RECOGNIZE BIASES IN OTHERS.

CONFIRMATION BIAS: THE TENDENCY TO SEARCH FOR OR INTERPRET INFORMATION IN A WAY THAT CONFIRMS ONE'S PRECONCEPTIONS.

FUNDAMENTAL ATTRIBUTION ERROR: THE TENDENCY FOR PEOPLE TO OVEREMPHASIZE PERSONALITY-BASED EXPLANATIONS FOR BEHAVIORS WHILE UNDEREMPHASIZING THE ROLE OF SITUATIONAL INFLUENCES ON THE SAME BEHAVIOR.
