1	<ul> <li>The first image shows a gold spoon on top of a plate with markings on it.</li> <li>The second image shows a compass in a box.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>The spoon and plate might have been the precursor to the compass.</li> <li>A compass can be used to find one's direction, so explorers used it to navigate the ocean.</li> </ul>
2	<ul> <li>The first image shows many gold circles with markings that look like they connect.</li> <li>The second image's gold circle has a bar in the middle that might point to a specific direction.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Maybe explorers used the device to tell the time of day.</li> <li>Maybe the arrows on the gold circles point to the direction needed to travel.</li> </ul>
3	<ul> <li>Both images show two similar wedge-shaped objects; one is gold, and one is wooden.</li> <li>Both objects have markings that look mathematical or scientific.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>The wedge-shaped objects look like they would be used for measuring angles, such as in geometry or in a scientific subject.</li> <li>Maybe explorers used them to calculate distance.</li> </ul>
4	<ul> <li>The images show two large ships; both are wooden and have big white sails.</li> <li>The first image's ship has triangular sails.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Explorers used the ships to cross the ocean.</li> <li>The sails harnessed the power of the wind currents over the ocean to help explorers travel more quickly and adjust their direction of travel.</li> </ul>
