

SOLVING EXPONENTIAL EQUATIONS: GUIDED NOTES

Notation

Common Logarithm

$$\log_{10} x = \log x$$

Natural Logarithm

$$\log_e x = \ln x$$

(where e is Euler's number: 2.7...)

Inverse Operations: Exponential and Logarithmic

$$10^{\log(x)} = x$$

$$\ln(e^x) = x$$

$$2^{\log_2 x} = x$$

$$\log_5(5^x) = x$$

2) $4 - 2e^x = -23$

3) $10^{-12x} + 6 = 100$

$$\log_b a = \frac{\log a}{\log b}$$
