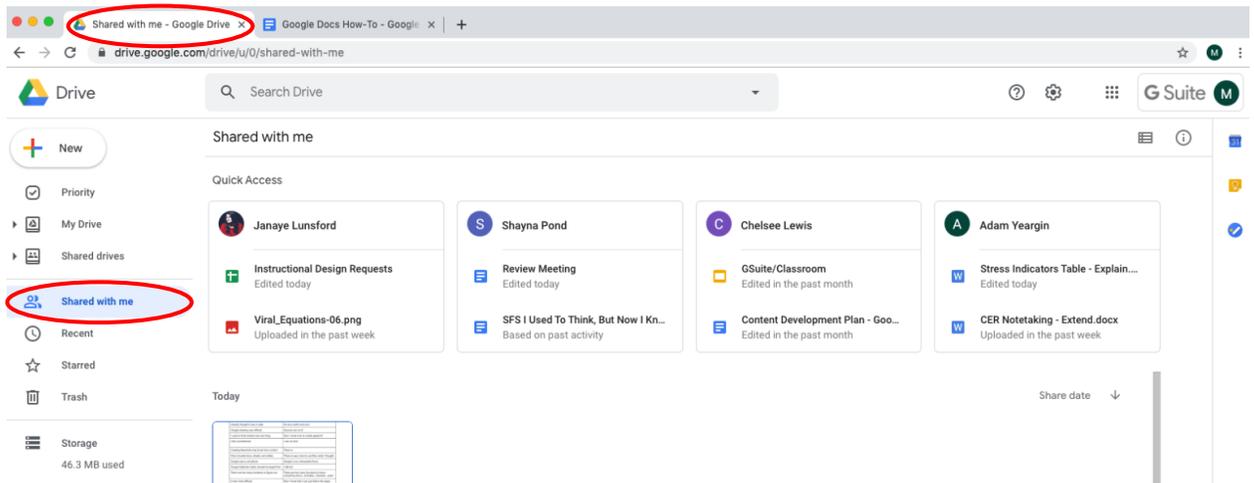
1. Click on “New,” choose Google Docs, and title.



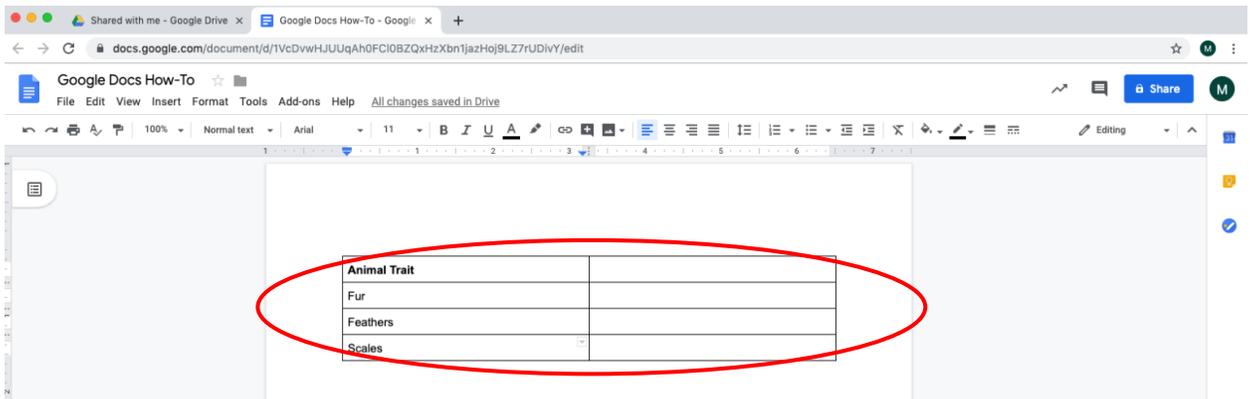
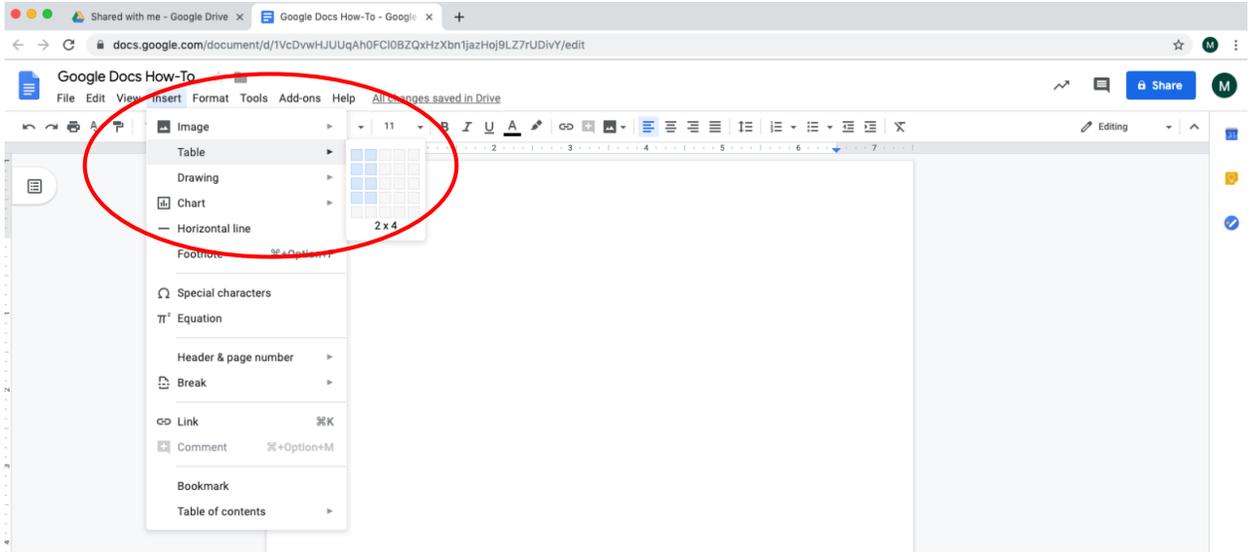
2. Share it with everyone in your group.



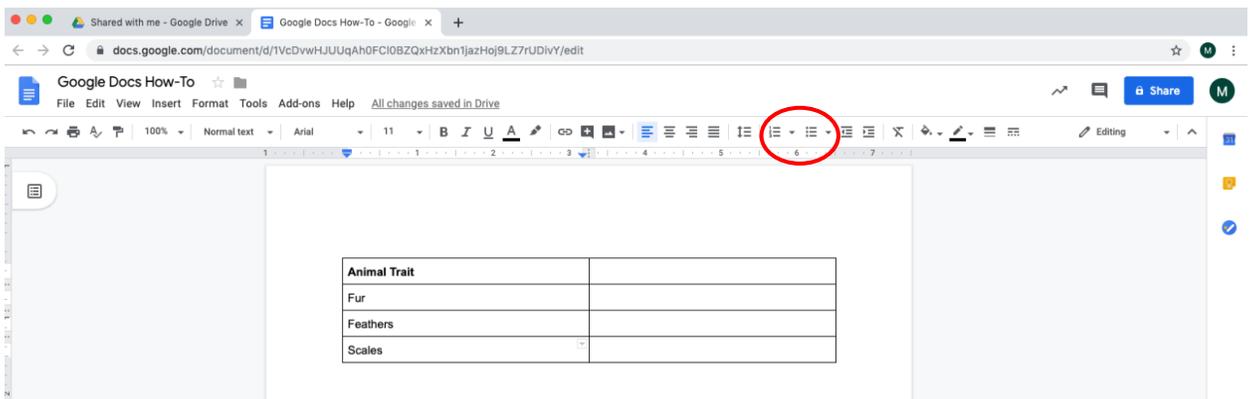
